Guidance on completing the Form

The application should be on no more than two sides of A4. Include supporting papers where necessary.

1. Project title

Please use a short, descriptive title.

2. Project Lead

The lead for the project and the person able to provide additional information if required during the assessment process. Also include details of a contact person for additional information if this is someone other than the Project Lead.

3. Funding Required

A detailed breakdown of the costs must be submitted with the application – how much are you spending in total, how much funding has been secured and how much funding is sought.

4. Project Description

Describe the rationale, aims, objectives, milestones/deliverables and timetable. i.e. What are you trying to do and by when and how potential funding will it be spent.

The project should:

- contribute towards the development of an individual or benefit the community of the Isle of Coll
- have the potential to improve community cohesion
- demonstrate value for money
- be feasible
- demonstrate evidence of inclusion

5. Fundraising to Date

A brief description of what has already been done, or planned, to fund the project.

6. Community Value

What is the anticipated benefit of your project? How will your project provide value to the Isle of Coll? How will it add value (Personal and/or Community)?

• Personal value: benefit individuals within our community.

• **Community value:** inclusion of different groups equitably and in a way that maximises benefit for the whole community.

7. Measuring Success

What is the baseline position? What measures will be used to gauge success? What will be the impact of this project? What outcomes/benefits will be measured and reported? How will the outcomes/benefits from the project be spread?

8. Submission
